Patient Dilation Consent Form

Dilating the pupil with eye drops allows Dr. Wood to obtain the most optimal view inside your eyes to monitor your eye health. Health problems such as diabetes, glaucoma, macular degeneration, cataracts, and high blood pressure can be detected even before the onset of any symptoms. It's possible that some of these eye conditions can go undetected without dilating your pupils. There is no additional charge to have the dilation; it is included as a part of your comprehensive eye exam.

The effects of dilation will last for 4-5 hours, and you may experience sensitivity to light and blurred vision while reading. Most people will be able to drive once their eyes are dilated. However, if you feel uncomfortable driving, or have never driven with your eyes dilated, it may be best to have a driver. Adverse reactions, such as acute angle closure glaucoma, may triggered by the dilation drops. This is extremely rare and can be treated with immediate medical attention.
